Plantable Paper Making Workshop

Plantable seed paper is all the rage right now and is very pricey. The market is hot for all things "green" so why not make it yourself?

Learn how to make plantable seed paper by recycling the paper we commonly find in our home or office and embedding wildflower seeds. Plant the paper and colorful wildflowers actually grow! Vegetable or herb seeds can be used as well. Use this biodegradable paper for greeting cards, wedding or baby shower favors, wedding confetti, etc, etc, the list is endless.

In this 3 hour "hands on" workshop each student will make a number of different seed papers; in different colors, shapes and sizes.

Class size is limited to 8. Please dress for mess, bring a small stack of newspapers, a package of handiwipes/easy wipes (disposable dish cloths) and a plastic grocery bag to carry your damp seed papers home.

Stained Glass (ac#1005)

This hands-on class introduces students to the basics of stained glass, which includes choosing glass, cutting, foiling, soldering and finishing. Each student can expect to finish one or two projects. All materials are included and experienced students are welcome to come and work with fellow artists in a group atmosphere. Missed classes can be made up and students can continue with studio time at \$7.00 per hour after the session is completed. New beginning and advanced classes repeat every 6 weeks. Days and evenings can be adjusted to accommodate students. If you have tools, bring them along.

Skies in Watercolor (#ac1008)

Learn to be free as the wind as you experiment with flowing color to create expressive skies. Wet in wet, resist, blotting, lifting, pouring, and other techniques for painting will be covered. Tall skies paintings, with a minimal landscape composition are our goal. All materials supplied.

Abstract Watercolor (#ac1009)

We will learn an approach to abstract painting that begins with the drawing of 4 real objects that will become the basis for an abstract painting experience. The use of collage, masking, lifting, resist, markers and color mixing will be part of the class content. This will be a painless journey into abstract painting. Supply list upon registration.

CHILDREN'S CLASSES

Drawing Animals (#cc1010)

For children ages 12 and up.

Instructor: Patty Rodgers, BFA

Time: Saturdays, 3 sessions, April 10, 17, and 24; 10am –12 noon.

Place: the AFAF gallery

Price: \$24 per session

Minimum: 5 students (no payment due until minimum is met)

Everyone loves animals. Learn to draw three dimensional forms by using stuffed animals as models. Bring your favorite stuffed animal or use one provided and learn proportion, foreshortening, overlapping, line quality and compositions. Students will be able to apply what they learn to drawing dogs, cats, or any other pet. We will also learn to draw three dimensional objects and make a complete finished picture.

May borrow drawing boards from the instructor.

Supplies needed: 16X20” newsprint sketch pad, 16X20” charcoal drawing sketch pad. Soft charcoal sticks (2B), crayons will be provided.

3. Register in Person. Walk right in and register for all of your classes at the gallery. Gallery hours are generally Thursday through Saturday, 10-4. Sunday, 12-4pm.

Class Fees

Class Fees are listed as Member/ Non-Member. Members save an additional \$10 per class! Payment in full is required prior to class start date. Reservations are held only with receipt of payment. Classes with low enrollment may be cancelled. Workshop payment is required one week before workshop. **Please note: class and/or workshop fees will not be pro-rated, and credit will not be issued for unattended classes.**

REFUND / CANCELATIONS

If you decide to withdraw from a class, you may do so on or before August 29th, 2009 to receive a full refund, less a \$25 processing fee. The refund will be issued in the manner in which you paid.

If you withdraw from a class after August 29th at 5 pm, NO monetary refund or credit toward a future class will be issued.

If a class or workshop is cancelled, a full refund will be issued in the manner in which it was paid. Refunds and/or credit will not be issued for classes missed. Withdrawals from a workshop must occur seven days or more prior to the workshop. The workshop fee, minus a \$10 processing fee will be credited towards a future workshop or class.

MAKE - UP CLASSES

AFAF will offer make-up classes for classes cancelled because of major holidays or extreme weather conditions. Students will be notified by phone or email when bad weather forces a cancellation. Classes cancelled because of a teacher's illness or emergency will be the responsibility of the teacher to reschedule. Make-up classes typically meet during the week immediately following each session and will be coordinated by the teacher. AFAF is not responsible for providing make-up classes for students who miss class.
