Make your own handmade paper by learning a technique to recycle paper yourself! Using ordinary items found around the house and garden, you can learn how to make a number of different types of beautiful papers. Techniques to vary the texture, thickness, and color of the papers will be explored and we will experiment with adding different kinds of “inclusions”, such as flower petals, decorative glitter, etc. to add a little pizzazz. A paper-making kit will be available for purchase from the instructor but is not necessary.

Drawing with charcoal (#ac1003)

Any level of drawing experience is fine for this class, teens to adults. Charcoal is a flexible, malleable medium that can be erased and changed. Mistakes are ok! We will be using still life set-ups and learn to use charcoal as a way of working out design problems for painting or as a finished piece. Topics covered will be composition, value, balance, movement and center of interest. Learn from each other in group critiques.

Supplies needed: 18 x 24 inch newsprint pad, 5 sheets 18x24 good quality white or off white charcoal paper (Strathmore, Canson are good). Drawing board to fit paper, two large bull dog clips, 4 to 5 compressed charcoal sticks in 2B to 4B (soft), 2 kneaded erasers, 1 gum or hard eraser.

This hands-on class introduces students to the basics of stained glass which includes choosing glass, cutting, foiling, soldering and finishing. Each student can expect to finish one or two projects. All materials are included and experienced students are welcome to come and work with fellow artists in a group atmosphere. Missed classes can be made up and students can continue with studio time at \$5.00 per hour after the session is completed.

Drawing Animals (#cc1010)

Everyone loves animals. Learn to draw three dimensional forms by using stuffed animals as models. Bring your favorite stuffed animal or use one provided and learn proportion, foreshortening, overlapping, line quality and compositions. Students will be able to apply what they learn to drawing dogs, cats, or any other pet. May borrow drawing boards from the instructor.

Supplies needed: #2 pencil, soft eraser, black water based marker (medium), small box of crayons, 12X18inch white drawing pad.

3. Register in Person. Walk right in and register for all of your classes at the gallery. Gallery hours are generally Thursday through Saturday, 10-4. Sunday, 12-4pm.

Class Fees

Class Fees are listed as Member/ Non-Member. Members save an additional \$10 per class! Payment in full is required prior to class start date. Reservations are held only with receipt of payment. Classes with low enrollment may be cancelled. Workshop payment is required one week before workshop. **Please note: class and/or workshop fees will not be pro-rated, and credit will not be issued for unattended classes.**

REFUND/CANCELATIONS

If you decide to withdraw from a class, you may do so on or before August 29th, 2009 to receive a full refund, less a \$25 processing fee. The refund will be issued in the manner in which you paid.

If you withdraw from a class after August 29th at 5 pm, NO monetary refund or credit toward a future class will be issued.

If a class or workshop is cancelled, a full refund will be issued in the manner in which it was paid. Refunds and/or credit will not be issued for classes missed.

Withdrawals from a workshop must occur seven days or more prior to the workshop. The workshop fee, minus a \$10 processing fee will be credited towards a future workshop or class.

MAKE-UP CLASSES

AFAF will offer make-up classes for classes cancelled because of major holidays or extreme weather conditions. Students will be notified by phone or email when bad weather forces a cancellation. Classes cancelled because of a teacher's illness or emergency will be the responsibility of the teacher to reschedule. Make-up classes typically meet during the week immediately following each session and will be coordinated by the teacher. AFAF is not responsible for providing make-up classes for students who miss class.
